Frosh week takes place during the first week back to school, and its primary objective is to help students **adjust to their new environment**. It is an opportunity for students to make new friends, as well as learn from upper-year students. The week consists of **friendly sporting competitions** and **various social events** for both first year and upper year students. ENGG WEEK

Engineering Week is a week at the start of each year, dedicated to taking pride in Engineering and developing a **sense of community** among fellow students.
